



- NPL branding to promote participation and investment
- More consistency in Community League structures
- Combination of U13 to 1<sup>st</sup> Grade facilitates development of strong clubs
- Reserve Grade reflects opportunity to engage senior players
- Diminished Community league is an unknown when considering participation numbers
- Club Championship may result in performance pressure on youth

## Commentary

- 182 Teams (5% growth on 2016)
- Women's PL 21 matches + finals in all age grades
- Women's SL and Girl's JL 22 matches + finals
- Promotes investment by 8 WPL clubs
- Reduces risk of depth of talent in youth football presenting a development obstacle
- Reserve Grade reflects opportunity to engage senior players
- NPL branding to promote participation and investment
- More consistency in Community League structures
- Combination of U13 to 1<sup>st</sup> Grade facilitates development of strong clubs
- 2 year split youth age grades in community football enables divisional tiering (to enhance experience)
- Monopoly on talented player pathway by 8 PL clubs
- Reduced number of clubs within the talented player pathway
- No consistency between WPL and Community youth age grades
- Clear underpinning program to the WPL Aligns to Pathway competitions of NTC (U17) and
- NYC (U15 and U13)
- Alignment to Women's NPL Framework:
  - Statewide league
  - **NPL branding and Criteria**
  - Partial three pillar talented player pathway
  - Partial consistency in age grades
  - Possible alignment of Men's and Women's **NPL Clubs**
