1. INTRODUCTION

Capital Football extends an invitation to new and continuing Futsal Junior (FJPL) & Senior (FPL) Premier League teams to apply for the upcoming 2018 FJPL and FPL season.

To reflect the FFA National Championship standards, the leagues will be played on international sized court for all FPL and FPL Youth matches. The FJPL competitions will be played on a standard sized court. All leagues will be used by selectors to identify potential players for the squads competing in the National Futsal Championships.

3. FPL & FJPL CRITERIA

Applications are due no later than Monday 10th September 2018 and must be accompanied by all relevant documents which are to be attached to the online nomination:

- Club affiliation letter (CF affiliated Club teams only)
- Team lists (<https://capitalfootball.com.au/futsal/premier-league/>)

Incomplete applications will not be accepted. Clubs/Teams will be invoiced directly by Capital Football once applications have been received and accepted.

All applications will be judged on a scale of 0 – 5 on the selection criteria and the standard of the team. In the instance where nominations exceed the competition limit, all teams will be ranked based on the selection criteria which will determine the successful applicants.

5. REGISTRATIONS

Individual player registration for the 2018 FPL & FJPL will be done online via MyFootballClub and all players will need to register with the club *Capital Futsal*. Players will not need to request a transfer if playing for a different club than their most recent registration. The full registration process is outlined below.

Registration Process

- **Step 1** – Club/Team delegate to complete online application form by 5pm Monday 10th September 2018: <https://form.jotform.co/82068493963873>
- **Step 2** – All players must register online via MyFootballClub under the club *Capital Futsal*.
- **Step 4** – Clubs/Teams will be invoiced once application has been accepted and payments to be made in full by Friday 12th October 2018.

6. FEES & FINES

The cost for the 2018 season is as stated below. Fees take into account: venue hire, venue staff, referee fees, registration fees, administration, media and trophies.

An additional **\$100.00 bond** will be charged to each Club/Team which will be reimbursed at the end of the season providing the Club is financial, no fines or forfeits issued. *Clubs/Teams will be invoiced for all team nomination fees.*

\$50.00 – late team nomination

\$50.00 – playing an unregistered player
\$150.00 – withdrawal of team during season
