All teams will be required to nominate via the online team application form, by Wednesday 11th September. Please note that this is an application form rather than a nomination form as applications will need to be assessed by CF before confirmation of position.

Please note:

- There have been some venue changes
- Futsal Fees are charged as a team fee as opposed to individual player fees
- Individual National Registration Fees from FFA will still be applied via Play Football

Please read the information carefully and ensure that applications are returned completed as soon as possible. Completed applications will be accepted in order of submission.

INSURANCE INFORMATION

Capital Football carries sports injury insurance with SLE Insurance through Gow Gates Insurance Brokers for registered members. To be a registered member of Capital Football a participant must have registered with Capital Football or a Capital Football affiliated club online via Play Football.

In the event of injury, please visit GowGates to create an account, and make a claim.

COMPETITION REGULATIONS AND DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS

The Futsal Premier League Competition Regulations are currently being reviewed prior to the 2019-2020 season and will be available on the <u>Capital Football Policies and Procedures Web Page</u>. The Futsal Premier League Competition will be run under the Capital Football Disputes and Disciplinary Regulations; this is also available on the <u>Capital Football Policies and Procedures Web Page</u>.

By registering a team in a Capital Football Futsal competition, you agree that your team will comply with the Competition Regulations and Disciplinary Regulations which govern it.

FEES

The fee structure for the 2019-2020 Futsal Premier League Competitions will be a team fee, rather than individual player fees. The team delegate will be sent an online payment form for the below amount. The cost per player should be divided amongst the individual players based on the number of players in each team (the more players registered the cheaper the individual cost).

Futsal 2019-2020 Team Fee Futsal Premier League - \$1,500.00 (incl. GST)

Fees take into account: venue hire, referee fees, registration, administration, trophies and Facility Infrastructure Levy.

Team Fees Due: Upon being sent an online payment form

PLAYER REGISTRATIONS

Players will still be required to register online via Play Football. Please ensure you select the correct package on Play Football below when registering as a player.

REGISTRATION PROCESS

Step 1 – The nominated Team Delegate is to complete the online *Team Application Form:*

<u>Step 2</u> – The nominated Team Delegate is to determine the individual player costs and collect the individual registration fees for each player in their team. The Team Delegate will be required to collect the team fees and submit full payment to Capital Football when completing their application form.

<u>Step 3</u> – All players must individually register via Play Football. This process is similar to registering for a Club for an outdoor competition. Players must complete a separate registration for multiple teams. Follow these steps to complete your individual registration:

- Go to <u>Play Football</u> and click on the 'Where Can I Play?' button and then on the 'Adult Football' tab. Search for 'Capital Futsal' and select that club or click <u>here</u> to go straight to the FPL 2019/20 season registration packages.
- 2. Click Start your Registration and follow the prompts
- 3. If you already have a Football Account sign in using your account details. If you do not have a Football Account, create an account and then log in. (NOTE: If this is your first time using Play Football, the system will find your old MyFootballClub account using your details and you will be able to claim that profile).
- 4. Select the person/s you are registering and select 'Continue'.
- 5. For Product Selection select 'Capital Futsal' as the Club, 'Player' as the role, 'Futsal' as the Football Type and 'Social' as the Playing Level.
- 6. This will bring up several packages to select from. Select the package that applies to you and follow the process.
- 7. If you were not registered for a team in the 2018/19 Summer Futsal Season, you will have to make your payment for the FFA National Registration Fee before you are allowed to register (\$3.15-\$5.25).

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Competitions are filled on a first come, first served basis upon full payment.
- Capital Football reserves the right to refuse a registration.
- Team names will be accepted at the discretion of the Futsal League Coordinator. Any offensive or inappropriate team names will be deemed unacceptable.

TEAM DELEGATES

Upon registering, each team must nominate a Team Delegate (TD). This person will be the point of contact for the team and be responsible for any communication between Capital Football. The TD may be contacted in regards to draw changes, venue changes and any other competition concerns and must ensure all relevant information is passed onto the team.

DELEGATE'S CHECKLIST

To complete a team registration, Team Delegates must ensure that the following has been completed and submitted to Capital Football:

- ✓ Team Application Form
- ✓ Full team payments once invoiced by CF
- ✓ All individual players have registered on Play Football

Late entries for competitions that are not full may be accepted.
