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1 WELCOME

Capital Football (CF) would like to extend an invitation to all new and continuing Women's teams to nominate for the upcoming 2019 Women's Summer competitions.

All teams will be required to nominate via the [online team nomination form](#), by **Monday 30th September**.

Please note:

- Nomination Fees are charged as a team fee as opposed to individual player fees, aside from FFA Registration Fees
- Please read the information carefully and ensure that applications are returned completed as soon as possible
- Completed applications will be accepted in order of submission.

2 COMPETITION OVERVIEW

The competitions on offer for the 2019 Women's Summer competitions will be as follows:

Women's Summer Sixes	6v6	Sunday 13 th October
Women's Masters Summer Sixes	6v6	Sunday 13 th October
Women's Masters	11v11	Sunday 13 th October

* Both competitive and social will be offered, delivery of both competitions will be dependent on number of nominations

Capital Football reserves the right to reasonably combine divisions to ensure a viable competition – should insufficient team nominations be received for any one competition; Capital Football may determine not to run the competition. Final competition details will be dependent on the number of teams nominating into the divisions.

4 TEAM NOMINATIONS

All teams wishing to participate in the 2019 Women's Summer season must have a nominated Team Delegate complete the [online team nomination form](#). This nomination form must be submitted by **Monday 30th September**. Late entries for competitions that are not full may be accepted.

Please note:

- Competitions are filled on a first come, first served basis upon full payment.
- Capital Football reserves the right to refuse a registration.

- Team names will be accepted at the discretion of the Junior Leagues Coordinator. Any offensive or inappropriate team names will be deemed unacceptable.

5 MATCH SCHEDULE AND RESULTS

Match Schedules for the 2019 Women’s Summer Competitions will be released a minimum of seven days prior to the commencement of the competition, and can be viewed on the [Capital Football Futsal Senior Social page](#).

Please Note: The match schedules are subject to change throughout the season. CF will endeavour to contact teams in the event of such changes, but please check the online draw on SportsTG each week prior to your matches.

6 INSURANCE INFORMATION

The Capital Football Insurance Provider is Gow Gates Insurance Brokers. Further information on insurance, can be viewed on the [Capital Football Insurance page](#). In the event of injury, please visit GowGates to create an account, and make a claim.

To be a registered member of Capital Football a participant must have registered with Capital Football or a Capital Football affiliated club online via the Play Football registration system.

7 COMPETITION REGULATIONS AND DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS

The 2019 Summer Football Competition Regulations will be applied to Women’s Summer Competitions and will be available on the [Capital Football Policies and Procedures Web Page](#).

By registering a team in a Capital Football competition, you agree that your team will comply with the Competition Regulations and Disciplinary Regulations which govern it.

8 ENTRY FEES

8.1. INDIVIDUAL PLAYER REGISTRATION FEES

Capital Football does not charge any individual player registration fees to participate in the 2019 Women’s Summer Competitions, however players are subject to individual National Registration Fees from FFA, which will be applied via Play Football at the time of registration.

8.2. TEAM ENTRY FEES

The fee structure for the 2019 Women’s Summer Social Competitions will be a team entry fee. This entry fee is to be paid via the online payment form, sent once confirmation of team has been communicated. The cost per player should be divided amongst the individual players based on the number of players in each team (i.e. the more players registered the cheaper the individual cost).

The team entry fee includes:

1. Venue Hire
2. Referee Fees
3. Registration
4. Administration
5. Insurance
6. Facilities Infrastructure Levy

10 TEAM SHEETS

Paper team sheets will be printed by venue managers, and teams will be required to fill out the numbers and names of all players participating in each match. This is to be completed upon arrival at the venue or prior to the match commencing.

11 PLAYER REGISTRATIONS

All players will be required to individually register online via Play Football. Please follow the below steps to assist in completing the individual player registration:

1. Go to [Play Football](#) and click on the 'Where Can I Play?' button and then on the 'Adult Football' tab. Search for 'Capital Futsal' and select that club or click [here](#) to go straight to the Women's Summer Competition registration packages.
2. Click Start your Registration and follow the prompts
3. If you already have a Football Account sign in using your account details. If you do not have a Football Account, create an account and then log in. (NOTE: If this is your first time using Play Football, the system will find your old MyFootballClub account using your details and you will be able to claim that profile).
4. Select the person/s you are registering and select 'Continue'.
5. This will bring up several packages to select from. Select the package that applies to you and follow the process.

Please ensure you select the correct package on Play Football, in accordance with the below when registering as a player:

Women's Masters Summer Sixes Football
Play Football Package - Women's Masters
Women's Masters Summer Football

12 TEAM DELEGATES

The nominated Team Delegate is the point of contact for the team and will be responsible for any communication between Capital Football and the team. The Team Delegate will be contacted regarding

draw changes, venue changes and any other competition concerns and must ensure all relevant information is passed onto the team.

The Team Delegate must ensure that the following has been completed and submitted to Capital Football:

- Team Application Form
- Full team payments – once sent Payment Form by CF
- All individual players have registered on [Play Football](#)
