



# Capital Football High School Futsal Cup 2023

Capital Football invites all ACT Secondary teams to nominate in the 2023 High School Futsal Cup. The nominations are open to both boys and girls teams for 7/8 and 9/10 competitions. There will be a separate North and South side competition. **Depending on team nominations the viability of separate North and South events will be dependent on team nominations. If there are insufficient team nominations for one event, we may combine multiple events into one on the same day.** Full information is included here, along with the team nomination form. **Please complete and return the team nomination forms by COB Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July 2023. Note: all competitions will be capped at 10 teams this year due to limited court space.**

**1 Team per school per competition (depending on numbers we may open this up to more teams from a school but we will keep you informed with this information).**

## COMPETITION INFORMATION

### Dates/Venues

Competitions will run in Term 2, Week 4 for the girls and Week 5 for the boys on the following dates:

- Boys and Girls Southside Yr 7/8 – Friday 21<sup>st</sup> July at Mpowerdome, Fadden
- Boys and Girls Northside Yr 7/8 – Wednesday 19<sup>th</sup> July at Lyneham Netball Centre
- Boys and Girls Northside Yr 9/10 – Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> July at Lyneham Netball Centre
- Boys and Girls Southside Yr 9/10 – Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> July at Mpowerdome, Fadden

### Competition Format/Rules

- Games will commence at 8.30am and conclude by 3:30pm on each day.
- 2 x 15 minute halves, 2 minute half time break.
- Teams will be guaranteed a minimum of 3 games.
- Games will be governed under FIFA's Laws of the Game 2022-23, and Capital Football's local playing rules.
- Players must play in their respective age group. Year 7/8 players can play up in the 9/10 competition provided they do not have a team in the 7/8 competition. Year 9/10 players will not be permitted to play down.

- Up to 12 players can be nominated in a team list.

### **Costs**

The cost per team is \$120.00. This covers the costs of court hire, referee payments, venue/medical staff and administration fees. Invoices will be sent out once nomination forms have been received.

## **RESPONSIBILITIES**

### **Schools will be responsible for the following:**

- Team nominations returned to Capital Football before Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July 2023
- Payments to be received once invoices have been distributed by the due date
- School representative to supervise on the day (teacher/coach)
- Supplying one size 4 match ball for the day
- Playing uniform
  - Numbered shirts
  - Shin pads
  - Shorts
  - Long socks
  - Non-marking footwear

### **Capital Football will be responsible for the following:**

- Producing draws
- Providing referees where possible
- Providing competition staff (venue managers, first aid, etc.)
- Invoicing schools
