SECTION 1: INTRODUCTION

Capital Football (CF) would like to extend an invitation to all new and continuing senior teams to nominate for the upcoming 2023-24 Summer Senior Futsal League season. The specific competition structures for the coming season are to be determined in accordance with the Government restrictions applied in an effort to manage the COVID-19 pandemic. Several options have been planned for and will be considered in the lead up to each kick off date. CF will communicate to all team delegates in regard to competition delivery in a timely manner.

For teams who wish to express their interest in the upcoming season please fill out this online JotForm.

Once teams and competitions are finalised, teams will be required to submit their nomination and payments via a JotForm which will be sent out to accepted teams, by COB Friday, 29th September

Please note:

- There have been some venue changes from last season
- Futsal fees are charged as a team fee as opposed to individual player fees
- Delivery of competitions is still to be determined based on Government restrictions due to COVID-19.
- Team payments will be made in conjunction with the team nomination Via the Online Jotform.

Please read the information carefully and ensure that the <u>online JotForm</u> is returned completed as soon as possible. Completed applications will be accepted in order of submission and are subject to competition availability.

SECTION 4: TEAM & PLAYER NOMINATIONS

All teams will be required to submit a nomination via the <u>online JotForm</u>, by COB Friday, 29th September. Late entries for competitions that are not full may be accepted.

Please note:

- Competitions are filled on a first come, first served basis upon full payment;
- Should your nominated competition be full, Capital Football will contact you to see if you would like to adjust your nomination for another competition, or place you on a waiting list for the nominated competition;
- Capital Football reserves the right to refuse a nomination;
- Team names will be accepted at the discretion of Capital Football. Any offensive or inappropriate team names will be deemed unacceptable, and teams will be required to nominate a new team name.

For player who wish to register individually and are looking for a team please submit this <u>online JotForm</u> to express interest in playing in one of the competitions available.

SECTION 5: MATCH SCHEDULE AND RESULTS

The match schedule will be released a minimum of seven days prior to the commencement of the competition, and will be accessible via the Capital Football Futsal Senior Futsal League page.

Please Note: the match schedules are subject to change throughout the season. CF will endeavour to contact teams in the event of such changes, but each Club is also asked to please check the online draw on Dribl each week prior to their matches.

SECTION 6: COMPETITION AND DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS

The 2023-24 CF Social Futsal Competition Regulations will be available prior to the commencement of the season. The regulations will be available on the <u>Capital Football Competition Regulations Web Page</u>. By registering a team in a Capital Football Futsal competition, you agree that your team will comply with the <u>Competition Regulations and Disciplinary Regulations</u> which govern it.

SECTION 7: ENTRY FEES

7.1 INDIVIDUAL PLAYER REGISTRATION FEES

Capital Football does not charge any individual player registration fees to participate in the 2023-24 Summer Senior Futsal League Competitions, however players are subject to individual National Registration Fees from Football Australia (FA).

7.2 TEAM ENTRY FEES

The fee structure for the 2023-24 Summer Senior Futsal League Competitions will be a team entry fee. Payment of this entry fee is to be completed in conjunction with the team nomination along with individual player registrations. The cost per player should be divided amongst the individual players based on the number of players in each team (i.e. the more players registered the cheaper the individual cost).

The team entry fee is \$1850 and includes:

- venue hire:
- referee fees;
- registration;
- administration;
- venue managers;
- trophies; and
- Facility Infrastructure Levy.

SECTION 8: PLAYER REGISTRATIONS

All players will be required to individually register online via Play Football. Players are asked to follow the below steps to in order to register:

- 1. Go to <u>Play Football</u> and click on the 'Re-Registering to play this season?' button and then on the 'Start typing the name of your club search bar. Search for 'Capital Futsal' and select that club or click here to go straight to the Senior Social Summer Futsal season registration packages.
- 2. Click Start your Registration and follow the prompts

- 3. If you already have a Football Account, sign in using your account details. If you do not have a Football Account, create an account and then log in. (NOTE: If this is your first-time using Play Football but you had a MyFootballClub account, the system will find your old MyFootballClub account using your details and you will be able to claim that profile).
- 4. Select the person/s you are registering and select 'Continue'.
- 5. For Product Selection select 'Capital Futsal' as the Club, 'Player' as the role, 'Futsal' as the Football Type and 'Senior' as the Playing Level.
- 6. This will bring up several packages to select from. Select the package that applies to you and follow the process.

Note: Players will be required to pay a registration fee of \$3.15 for players under the age of 18 and \$5.25 for players over the age of 18.

Please ensure you select the correct package on Play Football, in accordance with the list below when registering as a player:

SECTION 9: INSURANCE INFORMATION

The Capital Football insurance provider is Gow Gates Insurance Brokers. Further information on insurance, can be viewed on the <u>Capital Football Insurance page</u>. In the event of injury, please visit GowGates to create an account, and make a claim.

To be a registered member of Capital Football a participant must have registered with Capital Football or a Capital Football affiliated club online via the Play Football registration system. Only registered members can access Capital Football's insurance program.

SECTION 10: TEAM DELEGATES

The nominated Team Delegate is the point of contact for the team and is responsible for any communication between Capital Football and the team. The Team Delegate will be contacted in regards to draw changes, venue changes and any other competition concerns and must ensure all relevant information is passed onto the team.

The Team Delegate must ensure that the following has been completed and submitted to Capital Football:

- Online team nomination form
- Full team payment
- All individual players have registered on Play Football
