# INTRODUCTION

Capital Futsal is introducing a Premier branch to the Junior Futsal League. Its purpose is to provide players with a competition that is at the highest level of futsal in Canberra while avoiding interrupting their football commitments.

The JFL Premier will feature 6 team competitions for both Boys and Girls. The age groups of the competitions follow the Futsal Nationals structure and are as follows:

- Boys under 12s, 13s and 14s
- Girls under 13s and 15s

As these competitions are new, there will most likely be a learning curve for us in terms of how we run it. Once you have read through the rest of the document, please provide us with any suggestions or recommendations, using the contact details at the end, about how this structure suits you.

# MATCH SCHEDULE AND RESULTS

The season will be starting on the 13<sup>th</sup> of October and finishing the 8<sup>th</sup> of December. 9 rounds will be played on Friday nights and there will be 1 round of mid-week games for a total of 10 rounds. Finals will be played on the 15<sup>th</sup> of December. The draft schedule for the season is in the table below:

The match schedule will be released a minimum of seven days prior to the commencement of the competition and will be accessible via the Capital Football Junior Futsal page or Dribl.

Please Note: the match schedules are subject to change throughout the season. CF will endeavour to contact teams in the event of such changes, but each Club is also asked to please check the online draw on Dribl each week prior to their matches.

# **HOW TO JOIN**

The premier competition is primarily for players that have experience playing at a high level either in Futsal or Football. Please keep this in mind when submitting and EOI or team nomination.

If you are a **player** looking to join any of the competitions, you will need to submit an expression of interest form via <u>this link</u>. You will then be supplied with all the available trial dates for the futsal clubs/teams that will be featured in the competitions.

If you are a **team** interested in playing in any of the competitions, please submit a team nomination form via this link. Your nomination **does not** guarantee a spot for your team in the Premier competitions.

#### **ENTRY FEE**

All competitions will feature a team entry fee. The cost for each team will be provided to club/team delegates upon acceptance into a competition at the cost of \$1000 per team.

This fee must be paid prior to the commencement of the season. The fee structure includes all the following:

- venue hire
- referee fees
- insurance
- administration
- venue managers
- trophies
- facility infrastructure levy

# PLAYER REGISTRATIONS (NOT OPEN YET)

All players need to register once their team has been accepted into a competition and has paid the entry fee. Players are asked to follow the below steps to register:

Go to Play Football and click on "Re-Registering" button if you have an FFA number or "New to Football?" button if you don't. Search for 'Capital Futsal' in the search bar at the top and select that club or click TODO to go straight to the Junior Summer Futsal season registration packages.

Click Start your Registration and follow the prompts

If you already have a Football Account, sign in using your account details. If you do not have a Football Account, create an account and then log in. (NOTE: If this is your first-time using Play Football but you had a MyFootballClub account, the system will find your old MyFootballClub account using your details and you will be able to claim that profile).

Select the person/s you are registering and select 'Continue'.

For Product Selection select 'Capital Futsal' as the Club, 'Player' as the role, 'Futsal' as the Football Type and 'Premier' as the Playing Level.

This will bring up several packages to select from. Select the package that applies to you and follow the process.

Note: Players will be required to pay a registration fee of \$3.15 for players under the age of 18

Please ensure you select the correct package on Play Football, in accordance with the list below when registering as a player:

# INSURANCE INFORMATION

The Capital Football insurance provider is Gow Gates Insurance Brokers. Further information on insurance can be viewed on the Capital Football Insurance page. In the event of injury, please visit Gow Gates to create an account, and make a claim.

To be a registered member of Capital Football a participant must have registered with Capital Football or a Capital Football affiliated club online via the Play Football registration system. Only registered members can access Capital Football's insurance program.

#### TEAM DELEGATES

The nominated Team Delegate is the point of contact for the team and is responsible for any communication between Capital Football and the team. The Team Delegate is required be over the age of 18 and must have a valid WWVP card for the duration of the season. The Team Delegate will be contacted regarding draw changes, venue changes and any other competition concerns and must ensure all relevant information is passed onto the team.

The Team Delegate must ensure that the following has been completed and submitted to Capital Football before the start of the season:

- Team entry fee has been paid
- All individual players have registered on Play Football
- The team delegates will also be responsible for the communication of the rules and regulations to their team as the team delegate will be the first point of contact by CF if a regulation has not been followed.

# COMPETITION AND DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS

The Junior Futsal League Competition Regulations for competitions are currently available on the Capital Football Competition Regulations Web Page. By registering a team in a Capital Football Futsal competition, you agree that your team will comply with the Competition Regulations and Disciplinary Regulations which govern it.
