

Purpose of the Review

Evaluate NPL and CPL competitions for improved structure and pathways.

Key Principles

The review was guided by four key principles designed to ensure a competition structure that is fit for purpose, sustainable, and reflective of Canberra's unique football landscape.




Risks

The review identified several key risks impacting the effectiveness and sustainability of the current competition structure, which the recommended changes aim to address.

Consultation

The Review Committee engaged a wide range of stakeholders to gather input and ensure a collaborative approach. This included direct consultations with Clubs, Standing Advisory Committees, as well as key Capital Football staff.


